

Regulation 8600.1 SCHOOL BUS BEHAVIOR

Bus Conduct

A bus child may not walk home or get off the bus at any other stop than that which is assigned. Please do not send notes saying that your child may go to a friend's home. Once on the bus he/she may only get off at the assigned stop. Bus children must ride the bus.

In accordance with New Jersey School Law, the bus driver shall be in full charge of the school bus at all times. Although the bus driver shall attempt to settle discipline problems as they arise, unmanageable pupils shall be reported to the principal.

Pupils who create disturbances shall be subject to disciplinary action which may include suspension from school or exclusion from the bus.

When a child has been excluded from the bus the parents must assume responsibility to transport their child to and from school.

These rules are strict. Therefore, parents and teachers must impress upon children the importance of the rules and the importance of following them.
