

School Bus Safety Rules

School Bus Safety Rules for Students:

- Students must be at their assigned bus stop 10 minutes before your bus is scheduled to arrive.
- Never run to or from the bus.
- Stand back from the curb.
- Do not push or shove.
- Always obey the driver.
- Wait for the driver's signal before crossing.
- Always cross at least 10 feet in front of the bus.
- Never crawl under a school bus.
- Stay in your seat.
- Do not yell or shout.

School Bus Safety Tips for Motorists

- Be Alert! Watch for children playing and standing near school bus stops.
- Always stop for buses with flashing red lights.
- Be prepared to stop for buses flashing amber lights.
- Be cautious of school buses loading or unloading students--even if the lights are not flashing.
- Adhere to posted speed limits near school bus stops.
